sounds'. But this still leaves the question as to whether it is part of a work that survived.

There are difficult philosophical questions about criteria of identity in music. Can we, literally, give the *same* performance a second time? Is a composition played on wholly different instruments than that for which it was written (saxophones rather than viols, say) the *same* piece of music? However difficult these questions are, it nevertheless seems evident that there is some relationship between a performance and composition such that, though the performance was a 'one-off', the composition endures, to be realised in indefinitely many other performances. My own view is that the sense of futurity that transience engenders arises from the desire, or hope perhaps, that my life is not merely part of a meaningful performance, but written into a more enduring composition, and it is not clear to me that Begbie's innovative and illuminating reflections on time in music offer an adequate response to *this* source of the sense of futurity.

However that may be, what is unquestionably true is that he has given us an enriched and enriching way to think about these questions, and in the course of doing so has produced what is probably the most substantial book ever written on these themes.

Sergei (or more correctly, after his ordination: Sergii) Bulgakov was one of the most famous of the Russian émigrés who settled in the West after the Russian Revolution. Expelled in 1922 by Lenin, along with other intellectuals deemed hostile to the revolutionary cause, he eventually settled in Paris, where he became the first Dean and Professor of Dogmatic Theology of the newly-founded Institut St-Serge, the Russian Orthodox Institute and Seminary. He was soon, however, involved in controversy over his understanding of the place of Wisdom, or Sophia, in his theological scheme, though the controversy was as much to do with the jurisdictional rivalries among the émigré Russians; he was condemned by the Moscow Patriarchate, and by the synod of the Russian Orthodox Church in exile, though defended by his own metropolitan bishop, Evlogii, who had placed his community under the aegis of the ecumenical Patriarchate. Bulgakov was also deeply involved in the early stirrings of the ecumenical movement, especially in Great Britain through the then newly-founded Fellowship of St Alban and St Sergius.
