

# San Francisco Bay Shoreline Guide

**Hunters Point today**

was only for ball games and traffic jams. A reclaimed landfill that wraps around the stadium has been turned into a park with ample lawns and exercise stations. At low tide, mud flats are exposed and shorebirds arrive to feed. Fishermen try for perch, shuck, jacksmelt, and flounder off two piers here.

Hunters Point Shipyard lies to the north. Jets from San Francisco Airport gain altitude overhead. To the west is Candlestick Stadium and Bay View Park atop the hill that was carved away and leveled to fill the bayshore. Between Candlestick Point and Hunters Point is Yosemite Slough, which is slated to be restored. To the southwest is San Bruno Mountain and the explanation for wind in this area: Alamy Gap, which acts as a funnel. If the San Francisco agers are playing, expect heavy traffic. Windsurfers favor this site.

**GETTING AROUND**

The Bay Trail route moves from Terry Francis Boulevard to Illinois Street, onto Cargo Way and to Hunter's Head Park, where a dirt path leads to developed Bay Trail at India Basin Shoreline Park. From here south to Candlestick State Recreation Area, the Bay Trail is a planned alignment that runs through the currently shuttered Hunters Point Naval Shipyard. Until the trail is fully developed here, use the city's bike network to get to Candlestick. Take Cargo Way back to Third Street and head south. Then pick up Phelps, Paine, Keith, Carroll, Fitch and then Gilman to the state park entrance. Exercise normal caution in isolated industrial areas.

workforce, mostly African Americans, was hired and housed just upstage from the shipyards, in an arrangement similar to that at the Maritime yards and Marin City, and in Richmond.
